Extended Member Share in September

There will be no speaker for the September meeting, as we will be taking in the photo entries for the member show that evening. After the take-in is complete, we will have an extended member share for our members. There is no topic for the evening. As we should have more time than usual, members can either bring in 3 pictures to share, or do something more creative than usual, such as a short presentation. There should be time for about 2 minutes for each person, so please plan accordingly if you do a presentation. If you do something outside of what is normally done, please check first with the projectionist to be sure that we have the correct equipment.

There have been a lot of last-minute submissions for member share. We understand that everyone is busy, but it makes it much easier on the projectionist if the pictures are in to the projectionist by Tuesday, the day before the meeting. We would greatly appreciate it if submissions are not made the evening of the meeting unless there is an urgent reason, such as your email not getting through.

The October topic will be "Macro Photography".

PRESIDENTS CORNER by Stan John

Our annual All Members Show is on track and Takein is scheduled for our September general meeting on Sept. 24th. At our August meeting I requested volunteers with a Van or SUV to help load and transport the images from the Take-in, over the weekend, until the hanging on Tuesday Sept. 30. Two people volunteered their SUV's but with about 110 images to be housed and transported I believe we may need more. Please contact me if you can help in this effort. In the last few days several people have noted that many of the 16x20 frames available in local stores have outside dimensions that are slightly larger than the 19x23 limitation published in the show brochure. After consulting with the NCPS Board, we have agreed that we will allow a bit of a tolerance to that limitation. Thus, we will accept frames with an outside dimension of up 19.xx by 23.xx inches. Please note that the 19x23 limitation was established because of the limitations of exhibition space, and secondly because we want to emphasize the framed image and not an elaborate frame.

The next deadline is the Registration of the images you plan to enter in our show. This deadline is Sept. 15^{th} .

Take-in will be done at our next general meeting on Sept. 24th between 6 and 7 pm. The first part of the meeting will be devoted to take-in, which will be followed by an extended Member Share.

Proper Labeling and Wrapping are important elements of the Take-in. Labels need to be on the outside of the wrapping as well as on the back of the image mount. Wrapping is needed to prevent damage, which may occur between the frames while in storage and while in transport.

Christmas Party. It's time to start planning our annual Christmas Party. The key to this is finding a Volunteer to Host the Party. Please consider volunteering your house for the party this year. No date has been set for this event and the date selection can be set by the volunteer host in consultation with the NCPS Board. Typically this has been in early to mid December to avoid conflicts with other work or family gatherings. Please contact me if you can support us in this effort.

So hopefully one of you will step forward and take this on!!!
