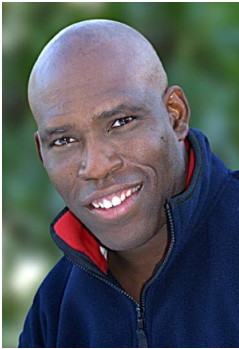

SEPTEMBER PROGRAM (Sept. 23, 2009)

Advanced Tonal Control of Digital Images In Photoshop by Stephen Burns



It's time for us to tackle the more advanced techniques for image manipulation in controlling your texture and luminosity throughout the tonal areas of your digital imagery. This presentation will share a sneak preview into what you will learn in the new "Creative Photoshop Compositing Techniques" workshop.

We will learn how to master the image in LAB using its channels to enhance color and texture. The techniques learned in this presentation can be applied to any digital image from one that is painted to one that is photographed.



I will address:

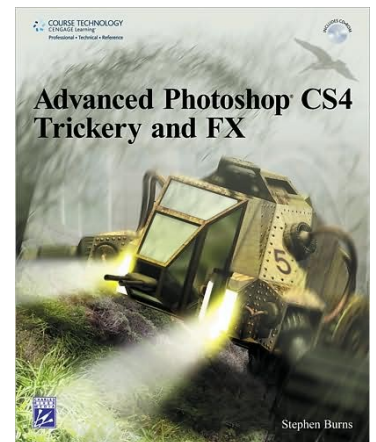
1) Learning how to enhance Color without using the color adjustments.

2) Learning how to sharpen your images without "Unsharp Mask".

3) You will discover the power of "Apply Image" and the "Calculations" command for controlling and enhancing your tonal details.

4) We will discuss why and how to apply the Layer Blend Modes to individual color Channels to assist you in enhancing our digital image.

STEPHEN BURNS is primarily renown for his digital expertise. But that has come after a solid grounding in many years of photography. He teaches and works with all things in the realm of digital art and photography. Many of you know him as president of the San Diego Photoshop Users Group (1500+ members!). Stephen also leads workshops for UCSD, the San Diego County Fair, the San Diego Natural History Museum, and Shutterbug Magazine - just to name a few... He has written a whole line of books on "Photoshop FX & Trickery," as well as being a contributing author to many other publications. He continues to be involved with Siggraph, a major player in the digital art world. And he's shown his digital fine art all over the world. On top



of all this, Stephen coordinated the entire San Diego County Fair's photo exhibition in 2007 and 2008. Previous to running the show, Stephen helped judge the exhibit. MEMBER SHARE by Barbara Swanson

The September membershare topic is "Rule of Thirds". Please bring one or two images to share.

The rule of thirds is a basic compositional tool that is often a good place to start when figuring out how to place elements within your picture. Very simply, think of your frame as a rectangle. Divide it horizontally into thirds with two lines, and vertically into thirds. The four points where the lines cross are powerful spots to place a subject. The lines are also powerful, and can be useful in deciding where to put things such as the horizon line. This rule also prevents a common composition error often seen with beginning photographers of placing the subject right in the center of the frame. Many photographs are composed using this basic tool, if you look at them and analyze them.

Queen Califia's Magical Circle

Date: Sunday September 20, 2009

Location: Kit Carson Park, Escondido



Queen Califia's Magical Circle is the only American sculpture garden and the last major international project created by Niki de Saint Phalle. Inspired by California's mythic, historic and cultural roots, the

garden consists of nine large-scale sculptures, a circular "snake wall" and maze entryway, sculpturally integrated bench seating, and native shrubs and trees. The garden bears the brilliant, unique mosaic ornamentation that is an unmistakable part of Saint Phalle's later work.

The Circle is situated within a 12-acre natural habitat in Kit Carson Park. The park's entrance is located five minutes from I-15 (Via Rancho Parkway Exit) at the corner of Bear Valley Parkway and Mary Lane. Turn into the park at Entrance Dr off Bear Valley Pkwy, go past the amphitheater and turn right. We will meet at the small parking lot on the right side of the road. Or you can proceed directly to the sculpture garden just east of the parking lot. For more info & a map, check out their web site.

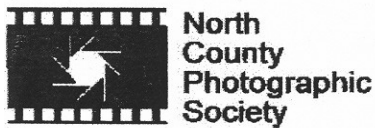
